## **DESCRIPTION OF REQUIREMENTS**

#### Introduction

The purpose of this Request for Information (RFI) is to provide the United Nations (UN) with the latest knowledge and capabilities of the market with respect to the latest technologies, solutions, systems, potential vendors with respect to the provision of Radio Production & Broadcast Studios. The gathered information will be used to determine the technologies feasibility, scope, cost estimate, timeframe, and resources required by the UN.

The UN expects to follow this RFI with a Request for Proposal (RFP) for Radio Broadcast System solutions that will be able to meet the operational requirements of the Office Away from Headquarters (OAH), the United Nations Global Service Centre (UNGSC) and both Peacekeeping and Political missions worldwide.

#### Use of Information

- 1.1. All costs for preparing a response for the RFI must be covered by the vendor.
- 1.2. The requested information will only be used by the UN for internal planning purposes, be kept strictly confidential and only authorized personnel will have access to it.
- 1.3. The response to this RFI will not be used to pre-qualify vendors.
- 1.4. The provided information will not be contractually binding to the vendor.

## 2. Current Situation and Goals

The United Nations has several field missions worldwide, often in remote and challenging environments. Effective communication is critical to the success of these missions. The United Nations is exploring the feasibility of deploying a broadcast radio system (containerized and standalone) to enhance our communication capabilities. The primary objectives of this RFI are to understand the current market offerings for the radio broadcast systems, identify potential suppliers with the capability to deliver and support such systems, and to gather information on technical specifications, features, and costs associated with these systems.

Interested vendors shall provide the following information that meets the following requirements:
