tonearingfullyenggeyouth, induring addescent gils and young women, in these efforts and to give the mavoice and seat at the table.

As Carackis youth delegate to the Commission on Population and Development, I call on all States to reflect critically on the principle of 'Nothing for Us, Without Us', which reinforces the importance of crouning that the people who are being impacted by your work have an apportunity to inform your work so that it reflects their experiences and needs. This can be done by empowering youth and ensuring full youth participation in leadership and decision making through an intersectional approach to other principles of equity, diversity and inclusion
