available sources of financing for education and health, in particular in areas such as family planning and reproductive health, which according to recent studies, will provide the highest return on investment and yield multiple benefits, allowing every pregnancy to be planned, reduction in teenage pregnancies and stunting, potential increase in school retention as well as stronger workforce participation of women. All this, will help to ensure that young population are empowered and contribute more to our national development efforts and post pandemic recovery.
