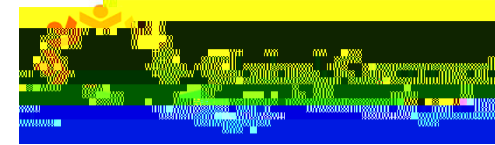
# Plenary Sessions

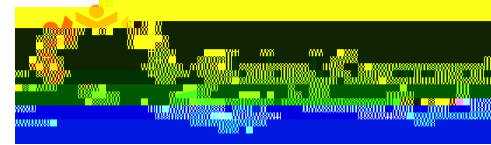
