Mr. Chairman,
Distinguished delegates,

My delegation supports the repression and punishment against crimes against humanity on the basis of respect for national sovereignty and non-intervention in domestic matters of other States, consistent with the principles enshrined in the Charter of the United Nations. However, we are not convinced that the analysis based on the practice of the ICC, which does not enjoy wide

With regard to the evidence of acceptance and recognition, we note that States with limited resources may be prevented from fully participating in creating materials carrying evidence of acceptance and recognition. The notion of 'a

large majority of States', therefore, should be carefully interpreted, in order to ensure that the Community of States as a whole is represented in the acceptance
