The Criminal Code criminalises different types of corruption and provides specific penalties, with prosecuting corruption and organised crime - the Office for the Suppression of Corruption and Organised Crime (USKOK), as well as a specialised police department within the Ministry of the Interior - the Police National Office for the Suppression of Corruption and Organised Crime (PNUSKOK) are established.

The Anti-Corruption Strategy for the 2015-2020 period sets out priority areas and targets crucial objectives for further development and strengthening of the anti-corruption mechanism. The Strateg1m
