ORDER No. 474 (20 22)

- 1. On 1 June 2022, the United Nations Dispute Tribunal (UNDT) in Geneva rendered Judgment No. UNDT/2022/054 in the case of Krioutchkov v the Secretary-General of the United Nations, rejecting Mr. Krioutchkov's application contesting the decision not to select him for a P-4 post of Russian Reviser, with the Department for General Assembly and Conference Managementin New York.
- 2. On 29 July 2022, Mr. Krioutchkov filed an appeal with the United Nations Appeals Tribunal (Appeals Tribunal or UNAT). The case is yet to be set down for hearing.

- 5. On 9 September 2022, the Secretary General submitted his response, indicating that he had no objections to Mr. Krioutchkov's motion for withdrawal.
