1. On 17 May 2024, the United Nations Dispute Tribunal (UNDT or Dispute Tribunal) issued Order No. 054 (GVA/2024) in the matter of Applicant v. Secretary -General of the United Nations, Case No. UNDT/GVA/2023/039. In this/Dispute Tribunal Order No. 054 (GVA/2024) (i7 (0)m1.2 5Tce)0.5 D.03[33]

10. On 24 June 2024, the Secretary-General submitted comments on the motion. The Secretary-General “has no objections to the motion”.

11. Under Article 18bis of the Appeals Tribunal Rules of Procedure, the President may issue any order which appears to be appropriate for the fair and expeditious management of the case and to do justice to the parties.

Given that the UNDT has suspended proceedings until the Appeals Tribunal addresses ABA’s interlocutory appeal, and the Respondent has no objection, I find that it serves the interest of justice and the expeditious hearing of cases for the Appeals Tribunal to consider this appeal at the Fall Session.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Appellant’s Motion for Expedited Consideration of UNAT Appeal No. 2024-1924 is GRANTED , and it will be reviewed in the UNAT’s 2024 Fall Session
