Informal meeting of the Liberian Country Specific Configuration
9 July 2014 (10:00 a.m., Conference Room 4, NLB)

Chair's Summary

1. The Liberia Configuration of the Peacebuilding Commission (PBC) convened an informal meeting on Wednesday, 9 July 2014 at the United Nations Headquarters. H.E. Mr. Mårten Grunditz, Chair of the Configuration, briefed the Configuration on his first visit to Monrovia,

information he had received, had the capacity of training 600 officers per year. The Government had received indications of possibilities to use training facilities in neighbouring countries. Overall, estimates projecting that approximately 5,500 officers could be trained by the end of FY 2015 still seemed rather realistic. That would be a somewhat smaller police service than the proportion of the population compared to countries such as Côte d'Ivoire or Sierra Leone and with possibilities to reach 7,000 within another two years.
