4. Recognizing the central importance of the fight against impunity, accountability and justice to building trust, sustainable peace and ensuring national reconciliation, and further highlighting the importance of the rule of law, its institutions, and transitional justice mechanisms in this regard, the Commission underlines the crucial need to provide adequate, predictable and sustainable financing, as well as technical and logistical support, for such institutions and mechanisms to perform their mandated tasks, most notably the Special Criminal Court and the Truth, Justice, Reparation and Reconciliation Commission. The Commission further highlights the importance of providing support to military justice.

5. The Commission underscores the enduring relevance of MINUSCA's deployment, and stresses the importance of all actors supporting the peacekeeping mission in implementing its mandate. The Commission further recalls the importance of enhanced multilateral and bilateral cooperation and coordination within the region and sub-region in assisting the Central African Republic with its peacebuilding processes, in accordance with its identified priorities and in full respect of the principle of national ownership. Reinforced mobilization and cooperation in the sub-region are particularly necessary on border issues including support to the Central African Border Management Commission.
