in the Cabinet. Mr. Carmignani spoke of the Governmentøu"cuuwtcpegs to honour commitments regarding the national dialogue process between State institutions, and to introduce a proposal for a national budget at the National Assembly. He highlighted the importance of reforming the public administration and other key sectors, as well as the need to address internal divisions within the PAIGC. The DSRSG welcomed the mutually reinforcing actions and statements of the international community and the mediation efforts of ECOWAS through its Special Envoy, former President Obasanjo. He reiterated UNIOGBISø"uwr rqtv, especially with regard to the national commission for dialogue and reconciliation and the stability pact, and welcomed the cooperation with the PBC and PBSO.

Portugal, Nigeria, Timor-Leste, the EU, Spain, Ethiopia, and Luxembourg took the floor to express satisfaction with
