

**Peacebuilding Commission
Informal Country-Specific Meeting on Central African Republic**

21 March 2012

Chair's Summary Note

1. The Peacebuilding Commission met on 21 March 2012 to discuss the situation in the Central African Republic. Attending the meeting via video link from Bangui were the Ministers of Defense, DDR and Justice of the Central African Republic, as well as the Special Representative of the Secretary-General in CAR, Ms. Margaret Vogt, and in New York, the Assistant Secretary-General for Peacebuilding Support, Ms. Judy Cheng-Hopkins.
2. The Permanent Representative of the Central African Republic to the United Nations, **Ambassador Charles-Armel Doubane** provided a brief update on the latest developments in his country since the last meeting of the Security Council in December 2011. Regarding the security situation, Ambassador Doubane explained that while much remained to be done, the Government had been able to address two ongoing security threats, namely the LRA and
