On 13 September 2018, the Secretary-General, Mr. António Guterres, met with the President of the Security Council, Mr. António Costa, to discuss the current situation in the Middle East and the role of the United Nations in the region. The Secretary-General expressed his deep concern over the humanitarian situation in Gaza and the need for a two-state solution. He also discussed the importance of maintaining the ceasefire and the need for a comprehensive and just peace agreement.

2. The Secretary-General also met with the President of the Human Rights Council, Mr. Volodymyr Hromyuk, to discuss the ongoing human rights violations in the Middle East. He emphasized the need for the Council to continue its work and to hold all parties accountable for their actions.

3. The Secretary-General also met with the President of the Economic and Social Council, Mr. António Costa, to discuss the impact of the conflict on the economy and the need for international cooperation to address the challenges. He also discussed the importance of maintaining the ceasefire and the need for a comprehensive and just peace agreement.
