Discussions at the retreat recognised that the 2020 review is taking place in a different context than the previous two Peacebuilding And itecture (PBA) reviews. The first, in 2010, assessed that the peacebuilding architecture had not lived up to the expectations sunounding its creation in 2005 and identified ways to strengthen the operations of PBSO, the PBC and the PBE.
