- 11. Taking note of the efforts by national and local authorities, with UN and ICGLR support, to identify specific cross-border cases and the required steps to advance prosecution and adjudication through cross-border judicial cooperation.
- 12. Welcoming the intention of the Network to develop a standard prosecution policy for the region as an essential mechanism to enhance cooperation on priority cases.
- 13. Encouraging countries of the Great Lakes region to assess their capacity-building and training needs in judicial cooperation matters, create national action plans and improve training programs for legal practitioners.
- 14. Calling upon the international community to provide adequate funding, active support and substantial technical assistance to enhance judicial cooperation among the countries of the Great Lakes region.
- 15. Encouraging the continuation of efforts underway in strengthening the role of women in political and peace processes in the region and the importance of youth inclusion.
