## Peacebuilding Commission's advice to the Security Council on South Sudan 11 March 2024

National Peacebuilding

*Priorities Framework Document* and its continued engagement with the Peacebuilding Commission. The Commission wishes to advise the Security Council to consider:

- 1. Reiterating and sustaining peace efforts.
- 2. While recognizing some progress

- *Ad Hoc* High-Level Committee for South Sudan (C5); the Intergovernmental Authority for Development (IGAD), including the Reconstituted Joint Monitoring and Evaluation Commission (RJMEC); national institutions; and civil society.
- 10. Noting with concern the continuing intercommunal violence, especially against women and children, calling on the RTGoNU to strengthen social cohesion in South Sudan, including through community-led peace dialogue processes to increase intercommunal security and national reconciliation initiatives.
- 11. Supporting enhancing the capacity of national justice actors across South Sudan to reinforce the rule of law and effectively investigate, prosecute and adjudicate serious crimes, in particular sexual- and gender-based violence and conflict-related sexual violence.
