The present volume constitutes the ninth supplement to the Repertoire of the Practice of the Security Council, 1946-1951, which was issued in 1954. It covers the proceedings of the Security Council from the 2262nd meeting, on 15 January 1981, to the 2565th meeting, on 14 December 1984. Further
