Resolution 2103 (2013) of 22 May 2013

Para.17: requests the Secretary-General to submit to the Council regular reports, every 180 days, on the implementation of this resolution and to continue to provide concurrent report on the implementation of resolution 2048 (2012) every 90 days restarting with the adoption of this resolution.

The report of the Secretary-General is expected to be issued in May 2014.

**Libya – ICC Prosecutor**

Resolution 1970 (2011) of 26 February 2011

Para.7: invites the Prosecutor to address the Security Council within two months of the adoption of this resolution and every six months thereafter on actions taken pursuant to this resolution.

The ICC Prosecutor is expected to brief the Security Council in May 2014.

**Somalia – UNSOM**

Resolution 2102 (2013) of 2 May 2013



### **Sudan/South Sudan – UNISFA**

Resolution 2126 (2013) of 25 November 2013

Para.24: requests the Secretary-General to continue to inform the Council of progress in implementing UNISFA's mandate in 90-day intervals, and continue to bring to the Council's immediate attention any serious violations of the above referenced agreements;

The report of the Secretary-General is expected to be issued in May 2014.

### **Sudan – 1591 Committee reporting**

Resolution 1591 (2005) of 29 March 2005

Para.3: decides, in light of the failure of all parties to the conflict in Darfur to fulfil their commitments, (a) to establish, in accordance with rule 28 of its provisional rules of procedure, a Committee of the Security Council consisting of all the members of the Council (herein “the Committee”), to undertake to following tasks: iv. to report at least every 90 days to the Security Council on its work.

The Chair of the 1591 Committee is expected to report to the Council in May 2014.

## **ASIA/MIDDLE EAST**

### **The situation in the Middle East, including the Palestinian question**

Resolution 1322 (2000) of 7 October 2000

Para.7: invites the Secretary-General to continue to follow the situation and to keep the Security Council informed.

### **Middle East (Lebanon) – Resolution 1559 (2004)**

further the Director-General of the OPCW and the Secretary-General to report in a coordinated manner, as needed, to the Security Council, non-compliance with this resolution or the OPCW Executive Council decision of 27 September 2013.

The report dated 25 April 2014 (S/2014/300) is before the Council.

**Middle East (Syria) – SG to report to SC on implementation of resolution 2139 (2014)**

Resolution 2139 (2014) of 22 February 2014

Para.17: requests the Secretary-General to report to the Council on the implementation of this resolution by all parties in Syria, in particular paragraphs 2 through 12, in 30 days of its adoption and every 30 days thereafter, and upon receipt of the Secretary-General's report, expresses its intent to take further steps in the case of non-compliance with this resolution;

The report of the Secretary-General is expected to be issued in May 2014.

**Middle East (Yemen) – 2140 Committee reporting**

Resolution 2140 (2014) of 26 February 2014

Para.19: (e) to report within 60 days to the Security Council on its work and thereafter to report as deemed necessary by the Committee;

The Chair of the 2140 Committee is expected to report to the Security Council in May 2014.

## EUROPE

**Resolutions 1160 (1998), 1199 (1998), 1203 (1998), 1239 (1999) and 1244 (1999) – UNMIK**

Resolution 1244 (1999) of 10 June 1999

Para.20: requests the Secretary-General to report to the Council at regular intervals on the implementation of this resolution, including reports from the leaderships of the international civil and security presences, the first reports to be submitted within 30 days of the adoption of this resolution

The report dated 29 April 2014 (S/2014/305) is before the Council.

**Bosnia and Herzegovina – Reports of High Representative to SC thru SG**

Resolution 2123 (2013) of 12 November 2013

Para.20: also requests the Secretary-General to continue to submit to the Council reports from the High Representative, in accordance with annex 10 of the Peace Agreement and the conclusions of the Peace Implementation Conference held in London on 4 and 5 December 1996 (S/1996/1012), and later Peace Implementation Conferences, on the implementation of the Peace Agreement and in particular on compliance by the parties with their commitments under that Agreement;

The report of the High Representative is expected to be submitted in May 2014.

### **Bosnia and Herzegovina – EUFOR ALTHEA/NATO reports to SC**

Resolution 2123 (2013) of 12 November 2013

Para.18: requests the Member States acting through or in cooperation with the EU and the Member States acting through or in cooperation with NATO to report to the Council on the activity of EUFOR ALTHEA and NATO Headquarters presence respectively, through the appropriate channels and at least at three-monthly intervals.

The reports are expected to be submitted in May 2014.

### **OTHER**

#### **Joint briefings by 3 Committees (Counter-Terrorism Committee, 1267/1989 Committee and 1540 Committee)**

S/PRST/2005/34 of 20 July 2005

Last para.: “The Security Council invites the three Committees to continue reporting on their activities at regular intervals and, where appropriate, in a coordinated manner.”

The Chairmen of the Committees are expected to brief the Council in May 2014.

#### **Non-proliferation/DPRK – 1718 Committee reports**

Resolution 1718 (2006) of 14 October 2006

Para.12: decides to establish, in accordance with rule 28 of its provisional rules of procedure, a Committee of the Security Council consisting of all the members of the Council, to undertake the following tasks: ...

(g) To report at least every 90 days to the Security Council on its work, with its observations and recommendations, in particular on ways to strengthen the effectiveness of the measures imposed by paragraph 8 above.

The Chair of the 1718 Committee is expected to report to the Security Council in May 2014.

#### **WMD – 1540 Committee**

Resolution 1977 (2011) of 20 April 2011

Para.4: again decides that the 1540 Committee should submit an annual Programme of Work to the Security Council before the end of each May, and decides that next Programme of Work will be prepared before 31 May 2011.
