The situation in the Middle East, including the Palestinian question

Resolution [1322 \(2000\)](#) of 7 October 2000

Para. 7: Invites the Secretary-General to continue to follow the situation and to keep the Security Council informed.

Middle East (Syria): Authorization of use of border crossings for humanitarian assistance and monitoring mechanism

Resolution [2585 \(2021\)](#) of 9 July 2021

Para. 2: Decides to extend the decisions in paragraphs 2 and 3 of Security Council resolution [2165 \(2014\)](#), for a period of six months, that is, until 10 January 2022, only for the border crossing at Bab al-Hawa with an extension of an additional six months, that is, until 10 July 2022, subject to the issuance of the Secretary-General's annual focus on transparency in operations, and progress on cross-line access in meeting humanitarian needs;

The authorization of use of border crossing for humanitarian assistance and monitoring mechanism will expire on 10 July 2022.
