Sudan Sanctions Regime

Background

On 15 April 2023, the UN Security Council adopted Resolution 2582, which renewed the Sudan sanctions regime for a further 12 months, until 15 April 2024. The resolution was adopted by a vote of 14 in favour, 0 against, and 0 abstentions. The resolution calls for the continuation of the sanctions regime established by Resolution 1556 (2004) and subsequent resolutions, with the aim of ending the conflict in Sudan and restoring peace and stability. It also calls for the Sudanese government to take steps to end the conflict and to allow humanitarian aid to reach the affected population.

Designation Criteria

The sanctions regime is designed to target individuals and entities that are involved in the conflict in Sudan, including those who are providing financial, logistical, or other support to the warring parties. The criteria for designation include:

- Individuals and entities who are involved in the conflict in Sudan, including those who are providing financial, logistical, or other support to the warring parties.
- Individuals and entities who are involved in the export of arms and other military equipment to Sudan.
- Individuals and entities who are involved in the provision of financial services to the warring parties.
- Individuals and entities who are involved in the provision of humanitarian aid to the warring parties.

Targeted Sanctions Measures

The sanctions regime includes a number of targeted measures, including:

• A ban on the export of arms and other military equipment to Sudan.

• A ban on the provision of financial services to the warring parties.

• A ban on the provision of humanitarian aid to the warring parties.

1591 Sanctions List

The 1591 Sanctions List includes the names of individuals and entities that are targeted by the sanctions regime. The list is maintained by the UN Security Council and is updated as needed. The list includes the names of individuals and entities who are involved in the conflict in Sudan, including those who are providing financial, logistical, or other support to the warring parties.

Panel of Experts on Sudan

The Panel of Experts on Sudan is a body of independent experts that was established by the UN Security Council in 2004. The panel's mandate is to monitor and report on the implementation of the Sudan sanctions regime. The panel has reported on a number of violations of the sanctions regime, including the export of arms and other military equipment to Sudan, the provision of financial services to the warring parties, and the provision of humanitarian aid to the warring parties.
