Every week, radio and television stations based in US territory broadcast to Cuba more than 1 889 hours through 30 different frequencies of medium and short wave, FM and TV. They generate some 228 to 253 hours a day of programs that have nothing to do with balanced and factual information.

Just for the fiscal year of 2007, the US Congress passed a budget of 36 100 000 dollars of federal funds for actions against Cuba, 10 million more than in 2004.

These increasingly astronomical amounts and the new methods used for radio and TV aggressions by the US Government against Cuba, prove a complete disregard for the rules governing international relations.

Of the 19 stations broadcasting subversive programs against Cuba, 14 aim their signals directly towards our country. Three of these latter, the Voice of the Americas and the so-called Radio and Television Martí, are owned by the United States Government.

Several of these stations belong or provide services to organizations linked to well-known terrorists living in and acting against Cuba from US territory, with full consent of the US Federal Administration authorities.
