GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR CONDUCTING CTC VISI TS TO MEMBER STATES

Introduction

CTC visits to Member States arecongnized in the Comittee Report on its revitalization (S/2004/124) and in UNSCR 153250(04) as one of the new tools to be used by the CTC in order effectively to fulfts mandate to motor implementation of UNSCR 1373 (2001). The CTC adoptede the following general guidelines for the conduct of such visits. Procedures for the paration, conduct and evaluation of the results of visits will be outlined in a separate document.

I. General Principles

- All UN Member States without and iscrimination may be subject to CTC visits;
- All such visits are to be made with consent of the State concerned unless the Security Council decides otherwise;

In arranging and conducting visits, the TC, when appropriate, may invite relevant international, regginal and sub-regional organizantis, as well as other United Nations bodies, including UNODC, anwelcomes their contribution to the fective fulfillment of the mission.
